


## NMAC Agreement to Arbitrate Must Be Signed On All Retail Contracts & Lease Agreements

For All Nissan Dealers

The Consumer Financial Protection Bureau (CFPB) recently released a proposed rule that would revise the Federal Arbitration Rule to prohibit financial services providers from using an arbitration agreement that prevents consumers from filing or participating in a class action lawsuit. **However, the new law has <u>not</u> been enacted**.

The Agreement to Arbitrate section must be signed by the buyer(s) or lessee(s) on all NMAC Retail Contracts and NMAC Lease Agreements. If this section is not signed, the retail contract or lease agreement will be returned to you, causing an unnecessary delay in funding.
