

Open data Use Licence

LUDO v.1.0

This license governs the provision of open data by Forseti SAS, registered in the Paris Trade and Companies Register under no. 820 867 877 ("**Doctrine**"), and the re-use of this data by any person who accepts and complies with these terms ("**you**").

In a few words, this license allows the re-use of data produced and/or enriched by Doctrine for research purposes or for non-commercial purposes, and to distribute the results of this exploitation openly and free of charge.

The goal is to promote widespread dissemination of data and contribute to the advancement of research and knowledge.

To which data does this license apply?

This license applies to any dataset to which it is attached ("**the data**"). The license can be attached to a dataset by any means, including finding a file containing its terms at the root of the dataset or by mentioning it through a hyperlink in the dataset's documentation notes. It is your responsibility to check for the possible presence of a license when using an open dataset.

What can I do with the published dataset?

This license grants you:

- non-exclusive,
- free of charge,
- worldwide,
- for the duration of the relevant intellectual property rights,

the right to freely reuse the data, including but not limited to reproducing, copying, adapting, modifying, extracting, and transforming the data.

It also allows for the dissemination of the results of these processes ("**the reuse**").

What restrictions apply to these rights?

These rights are granted to you on the condition that:

- Your reuse is for academic or university research purposes, or carried out in a non-commercial context. This means, in particular, that the results of your reuse cannot be transferred for any consideration or be integrated into a product or service that is subject to transfers for any consideration.
- You mention the source of the data used, the name of the person granting you this license (in this case, Doctrine), and the date of their last update.
- In the case of disseminating the results of your reuse subject to another license, that the latter does not contain provisions contrary to this license.

Who is responsible for what?

You are solely responsible for your reuse of the data, which is provided to you free of charge and without any warranty. Doctrine cannot be held responsible for any consequences and claims arising from your reuse of the data. Of course, you remain responsible for compliance with applicable laws.

In particular, if the data contains personal data, it is reminded that you are responsible for the processing of this data, within the meaning of European Regulation No. 2016/679 of April 27, 2016 (GDPR), and as such, you are solely obligated to a number of obligations, to which Doctrine is not in any way bound.

What is the source of the data?

The disseminated data originates either from proprietary datasets or from reused and enriched open datasets. In the event that the data comes from proprietary sources, Doctrine confirms having obtained the right to redistribute them. In the case of data originating from open sources, Doctrine confirms that their license allows for redistribution under these terms.

Can I reuse this license?

Yes, just change the names of the parties.

Who should I contact in the event of a dispute?

Any disputes related to the implementation of this license shall be brought before the competent French courts and shall be judged under French law.
